At Nassau Financial, the safety and security of our member's finances is our utmost priority. With the current pandemic and financial crimes on the rise, we are taking extra precautions to safeguard your funds.

Your current ATM card does not meet the safety requirements to protect against emerging threats.

As a precautionary measure, we have made the decision to disable your current ATM card effective 2/1/2021. To continue to withdraw funds from your savings account through an ATM you will need to open a free Checking Account so we can issue you a secure EMV chip-enabled Debit Card. To open a new Checking Account, you can visit our website at www.NassauFinancial.org or visit us in a branch. If you already have a Checking Account and a Nassau Financial Debit Card linked to the account, no further action is required.
